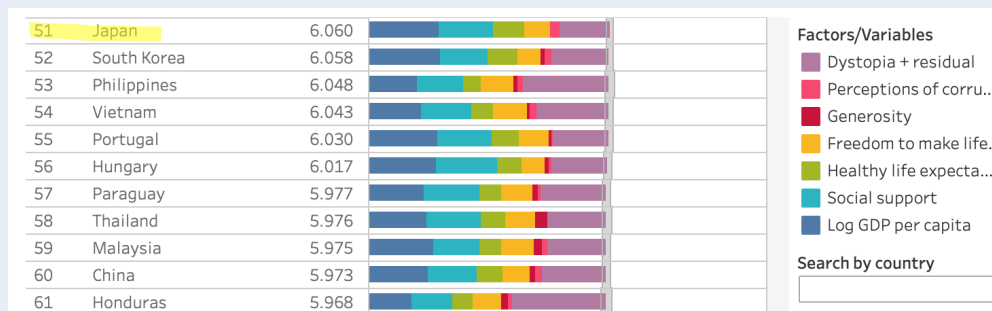
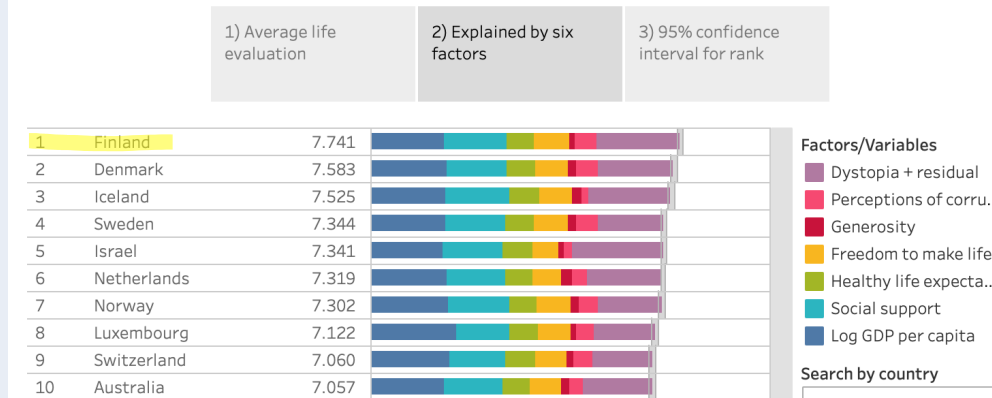

Tab 1 & 2: The 95% confidence interval is shown in the grey-shaded area at the end of each life evaluation bar.

Tab 2: The sub-bars have no impact on the total score reported for each country. Instead, they are a way of explaining the implications of the model estimated in Table 2.1. The few countries that have empty bars do not have sufficient information for the calculation of portions explained by individual factors. These countries still have their overall scores, though, which are based entirely on survey responses, and are independent of our efforts to explore the underlying support factors of happiness.

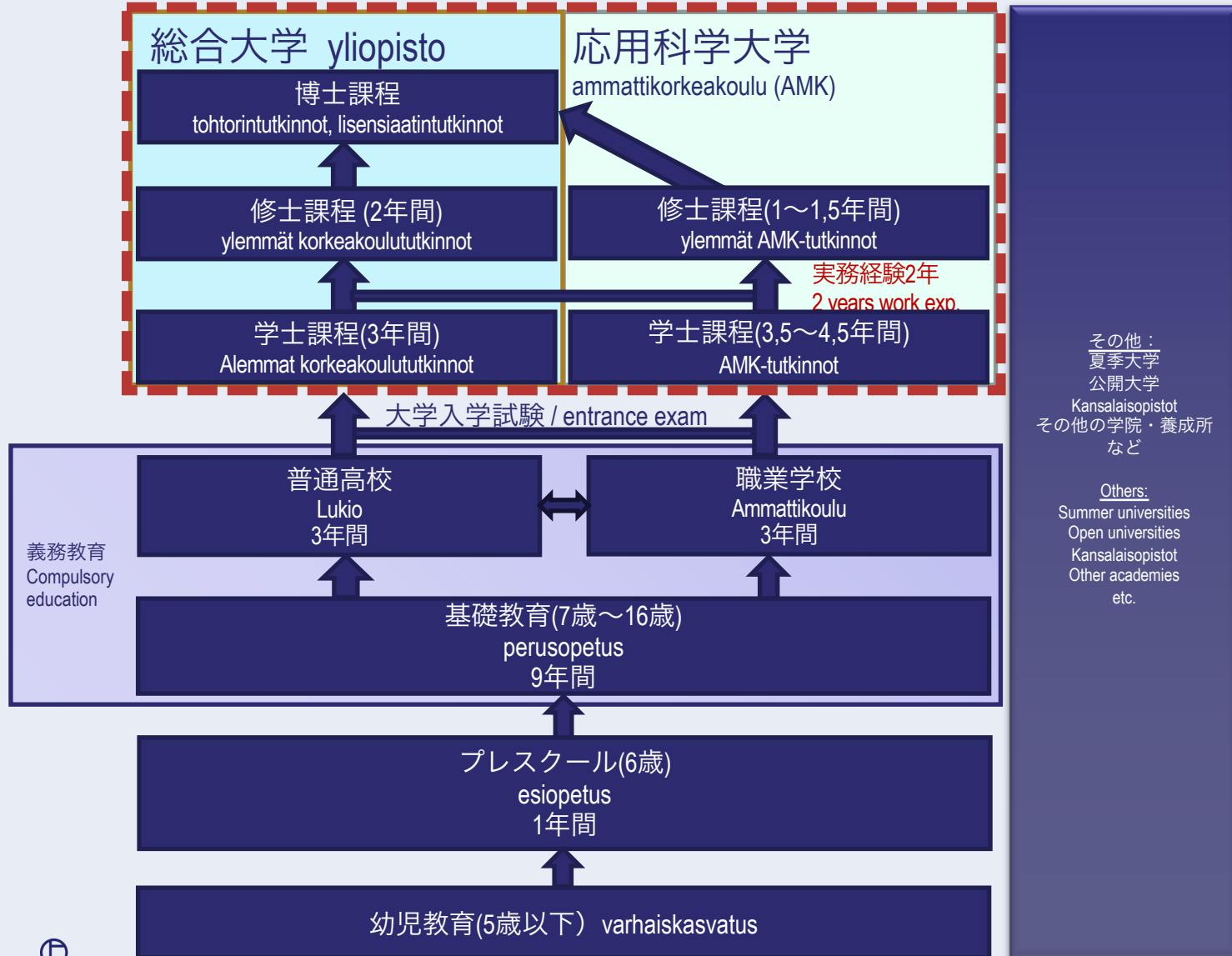

交換留学 / Exchange studies

(updated 2024/3/26)

- 所属大学がフィンランドの大学と提携していることが必須
- 所属大学による学内選考を経て留学が決まる
- 留学期間：半年～1年程度
- 単位は取るが、学位取得留学ではない
- Exchange based on bilateral agreements between universities
- Students need to be nominated by their home university in order to apply
- Exchange period is usually from six months to one year
- Students get credits for their studies, but can not get a full degree

個人留学 / Visiting student, freemover

(updated 2024/3/26)

- 留学期間：2か月～1年程度
- 大学間の協定がない
- 大学探しなどの手続きは基本にご自身で進める必要がある
- 学費を払う必要があることが多い
- 単位は取るが、在籍する大学にて単位認定してもらえない場合があります
- フィンランドの全ての大学が Freemover を受け入れている訳ではないのでご注意ください！
- Exchange period is usually from two months to one academic year depending on the university
- No bilateral agreement between the universities
- Students search and contact host universities by themselves
- Students usually pay tuition fees themselves
- Students get credits, but they might not be accepted at their home university
- Note that not all universities in Finland accept freemovers!

(updated 2024/02/27)

- 学費：年間5000～18 000ユーロ
 - 家賃：都市とアパートによる。地方都市で1か月200ユーロ前後、首都圏で1か月400ユーロ前後
 - 学生自治会会費（総合大学）：年間約50～83ユーロ
 - 生活費：1ヶ月約700～900ユーロ
- Tuition fees: 5,000–18,000 euros per year
 - Accommodation: Depends on the area and type of apartment. In smaller cities around 200 euros, in the capital area around 400 euros per month
 - Student union fees (universities): 50–83 euros per year
 - Monthly living costs: 700–900 euros per month

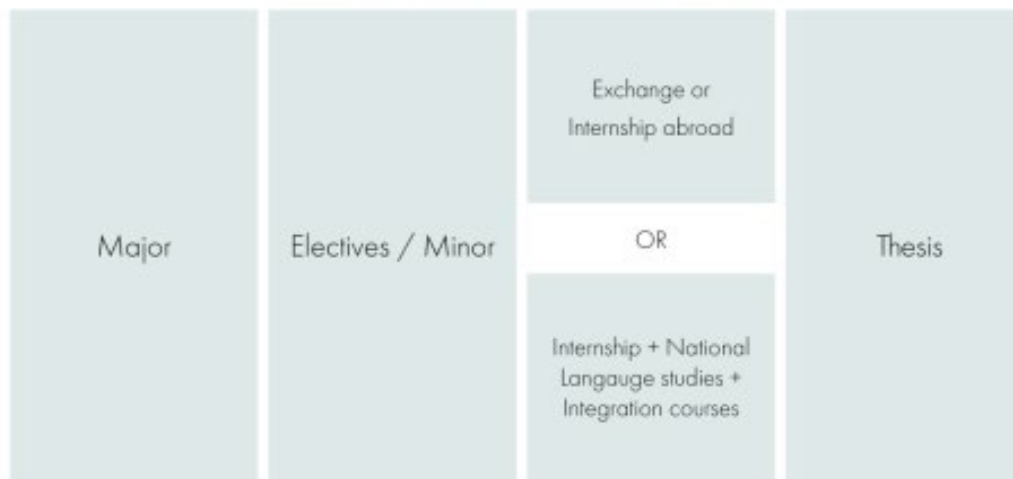

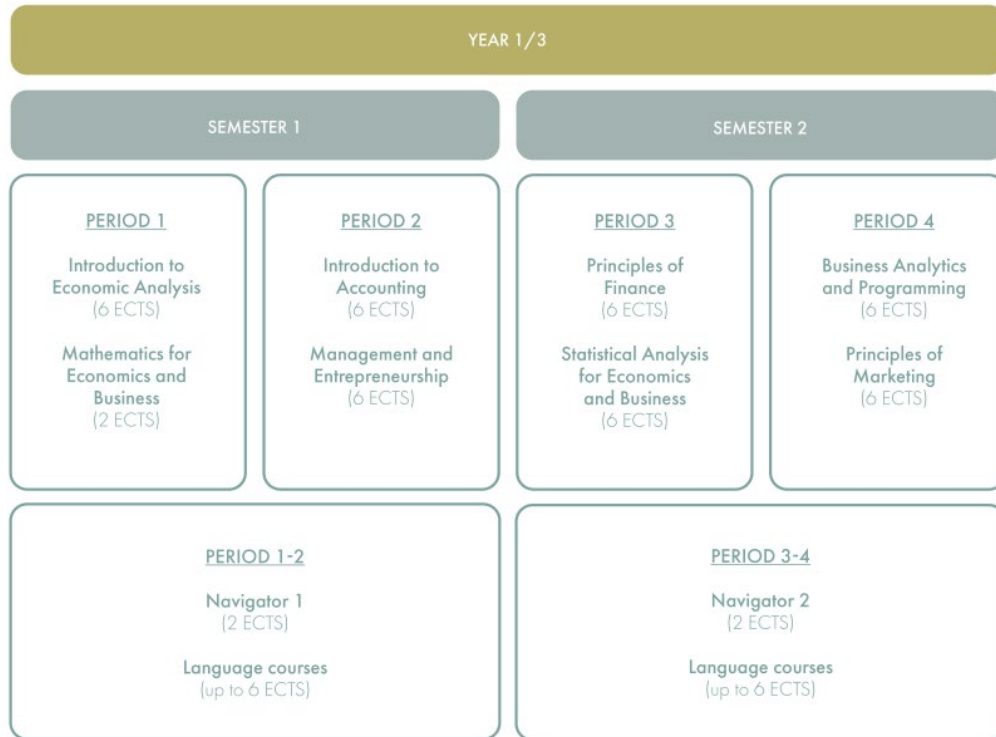

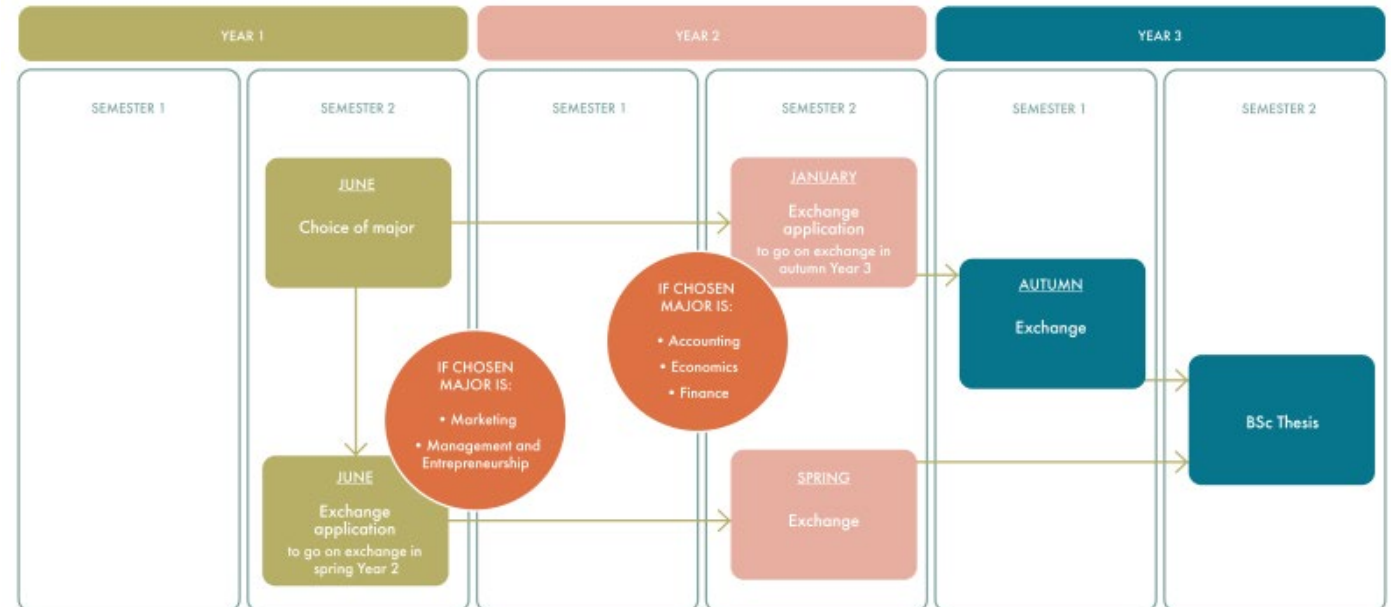

Application & admission

- Application done on studyinfo.fi
- SAT/ACT
 - SAT: min. 1100, ACT: min. 22
 - Must be done before application period opens
- Certificate
 - Only first-time applicants, passed grade in maths
 - Finnish Matriculation Examination, International Baccalaureate, European Baccalaureate, Reifeprüfung/Deutsche Internationales Abitur completed in Finland
- Admission results in April/May
 - Time until July to accept offer

Admissions criteria:

- General access requirements for university level studies.
- English language skill requirement incorporated in admission method.

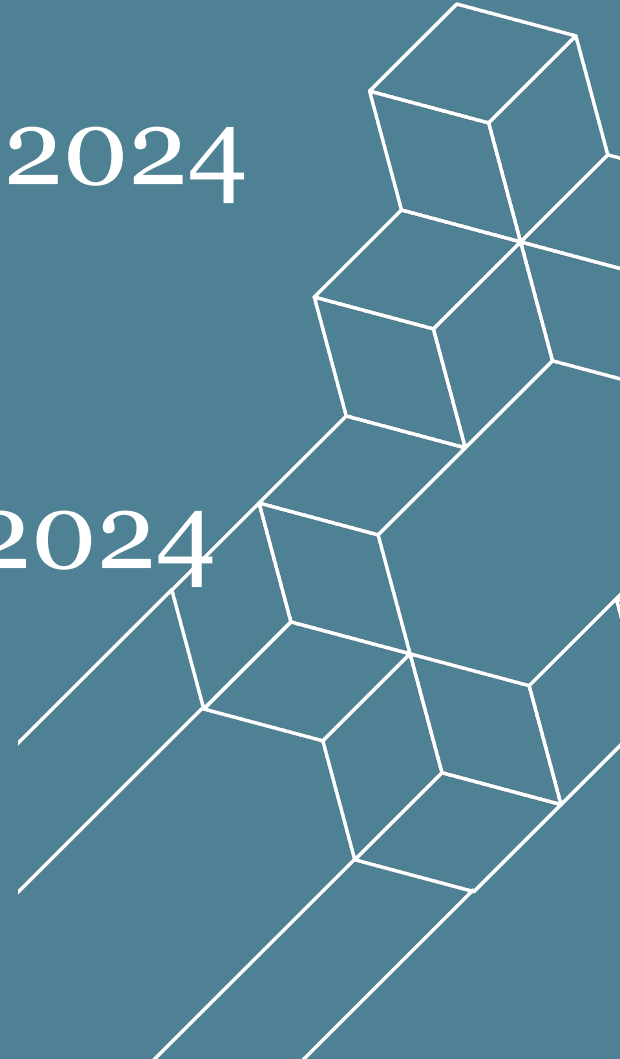

(next one in January 2025)



What's the difference between rolling and main admission?

Rolling Admission

- Only to the following programmes:
 - *Humanitarian Logistics*
 - *International Strategy and Sustainability*
 - *Marketing*
 - *Marketing and Management*
- *Fast track admission* – admission results in around 4 weeks after submitting your application.
- Only for applicants applying based on a ***degree obtained outside Finland.***
- Higher admission requirements.

Main Admission

- Admission to all programmes + Double Degree programme
- Open to all eligible applicants
- Admission results by the end of March annually.
- Admission process includes several steps, e.g. *academic evaluation.*

In both admission rounds, the student get the Scholarship decision simultaneously with the admission result.



Degree requirements and previous studies

Rolling Admission

- **Bachelor's degree with the major subject Business Administration and/or Economics** from a recognised university or a university of applied sciences located *outside Finland*.

OR

- if the degree does not clearly state the degree's major subject to be Business Administration and/or Economics, then your BSc degree needs to include **at least the equivalent of 80 ECTS of studies in Business Administration and/or Economics**.

Main Admission

- **Bachelor's or Master's degree** from a recognised university or university of applied sciences and
- **And at least 30 ECTS in subjects relevant for desired master's programme.**

You can also apply with an incomplete degree, as long as you graduate before July 31!

What does “recognised” mean?

The institution is a recognised part of the official national education system of the country. It has to be accredited as a degree-granting higher education institution by the country where it is located or by a relevant international organisation (such as UNESCO).

GMAT/ GRE or GPA requirement

Rolling Admission round

Applicants applying based on a degree obtained in a country outside EU/EEA, must fulfill one of the following:

- GMAT™/GMAT™ Online Exam ≥ 600
- GMAT™ Focus Edition ≥ 555
- GRE General test ≥ 158 in the *Quantitative Reasoning section*

English language requirement

If you are applying based on a GMAT or GRE score result your language skills are considered sufficient if you meet the [minimum score levels for admission](#).

Main admissions round


Applicants applying based on a degree obtained in a country outside EU/EEA, must fulfill one of the following:

- GMAT™/GMAT™ Online Exam ≥ 550
- GMAT™ Focus Edition ≥ 515
- GRE General test ≥ 150 in the *Quantitative Reasoning section*

English language requirement

If you are applying based on a GMAT or GRE score result your language skills are considered sufficient if you meet the [minimum score levels for admission](#).





Fees and funding

- Studies free of charge for EU/EEA citizens
- The tuition fee for non-EU/EEA students at Hanken is **12 000 EUR/year Bachelor** and **15 000 EUR/year Master**
- You are exempted from tuition fees if you hold one of [the accepted Finnish residence permits](#).
- Applying for a scholarship will not affect your application to the Master's Degree Programme.
- *Scholarships at Hanken are merit-based. They are awarded based on the applicant's academic excellence in the previous studies and applicable test score results. They are 50% or 25%.*

Scholarships, admissions phase

Finland Scholarship

- **Tuition fee waiver 100 % for first academic year of enrolment and 5000 EUR re-location grant.**
 - The re-location grant is transferred to the scholarship recipient if they have completed 10 ECTS during Teaching Period 1 (the scholarship is transferred in the end of November).
- The Finland Scholarship is financed by the Ministry of Education and Culture in Finland.





Scholarships, admissions phase

Hanken Premium Waiver

- **Tuition fee waiver of 50 % of tuition fee for duration of first degree at Hanken.**

Validity: 2 years for Master's, 3 years for Bachelor

Hanken Waiver

- **Tuition fee waiver of 25 % of tuition fee for first academic year of enrolment.**
- **Validity: First academic year of enrolment only.**





Scholarships, 2nd year

Hanken honor waiver from autumn 2025

- Tuition fee waiver of 25 % of tuition fee for second year of enrolment.
- Granted annually (for 2nd year of enrolment)
- Validity: maximum 1 year
